Project Summary

Lake Havasu has been a popular fishing location since its creation in 1938. Over many decades traffic on the lake has increased to an estimated 3.5 million visitors per year. The newly installed GatorDock systems and ramps at Windsor Docks launch between 700 to 1300 boats on each weekend day; making it the busiest boat launch site in Arizona. During this project, GatorDock's environmentally friendly solutions helped ease permitting processes and gain support from the local fishing community. Gator's large team of supportive project managers, engineers and designers created many custom solutions to combat the disadvantages and heavy wear-and-tear areas of the previous dock system. Lake Havasu's new Windsor Dock systems will provide decades of high traffic durability and safe, recreational enjoyment. Residents and tourists love the new GatorDock systems and say it is a welcome addition which has alleviated congestion and inefficiency issues, allowing for more time on the water.
